Doctoral students may enter the program with credit for prior graduate work, but will only be approved for up to 9 transfer credit hours that can be applied towards their degree. We evaluate transfer credit for students entering with prior graduate coursework on an individual basis once they have been admitted to the program, but typically tell our applicants not to assume they will receive credit for prior coursework, and will still need to spend approximately 5 years (inclusive of predoctoral internship) in the program before graduating with their doctoral degree.
